

## Malcolm Smith, MD, New Chief of Orthopedic Trauma and Vice Chair of the Department of Orthopedics

Dr. Smith is a renowned and experienced clinician, who most recently served as Chief of the Orthopaedic Trauma Center at Massachusetts General Hospital. He is recognized internationally for his expertise in orthopedic trauma and fractures and has an extensive background in the management of polytrauma, pelvic and acetabular surgery, open fracture management, minimally invasive plating techniques and post-traumatic reconstruction.

He was recruited by the Harvard Department of Orthopaedic Surgery in 2001.
