

Symptoms	Isolation
Negative test and never had symptoms	<p>a) Confirmed exposure* - 14 days isolation</p> <p>b) If no known contact with Covid-19 positive person- cleared to return to normal activities with ongoing monitoring – mask, hand washing, etc)</p> <p>c) <i>Special situation:</i> Health care personnel and essential workers: 24 hours since test</p>
Negative test and symptomatic	At least 1 days (24 hours) have passed since recovery defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement in respiratory symptoms.
Negative test and no current sx	**assuming prior symptoms** At least 1 days (24 hours) have passed since recovery defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement in respiratory symptoms.
Positive test (or presumed pos) and symptomatic	At least 1 days (24 hours) have passed since recovery defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement in respiratory symptoms and at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
Positive test (or presumed pos) and symptoms resolved (initial positive test)	At least 1 days (24 hours) have passed since recovery defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement in respiratory symptoms and at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
Positive test (or presumed pos) and symptoms resolved (subsequent positive test after quarantine)	If patient remains asymptomatic, they do not need to go into isolation again.
Positive test and never had symptoms	At least 14 days have passed since the date of their positive test assuming they have not subsequently developed symptoms since testing date.
Confirmed exposure* and no symptoms	Isolation for 14 days
Confirmed exposure* and symptoms	Isolation, patient qualifies for testing

*Confirmed exposure = close contact with a known positive for 15+ minutes (i.e. household member tested positive)
