Only emergency or other medically necessary care provided within a Hospital Facility by the Hospital Facility itself is covered by the FAP – i.e., the FAP applies only to (i) emergency or other medically necessary care provided by employees (e.g., nurses) of the Hospital Facility and (ii) other costs incurred directly by a Hospital Facility with respect to the provision of such care.
